

## **Incentive Scheme for Passenger Airlines**

BCIA is pleased to offer an Incentive Scheme for passenger airlines launching long-haul international flights from Beijing Airport to better serve China's Beijing-Tianjin-Hebei Collaborative Development Strategy and Belt and Road Collaborative Initiative, and to build Beijing Airport into an international air hub. .

### **Incentive Scheme on Landing Fee at Beijing Airport**

<b>Beneficiary</b>	<b>1<sup>st</sup> Year</b>	<b>2<sup>nd</sup> Year</b>
<b>Passenger carriers launching new scheduled international routes</b>	100%	50%
<b>Passenger carriers operating new scheduled international flights</b>	50%	20%

The beneficiary new scheduled international routes are referred that passenger airlines operate direct flight to new destinations. The long-haul route should be with the range of above 5000km (including) or the routes connecting "Belt and Road" countries.

The beneficiary new scheduled international flights are referred that passenger airlines operate direct flight to destinations already served by Beijing Airport or increase flights on the route. The long-haul route should be with the range of above 5000km (including) or the routes connecting “Belt and Road” counties.

“Belt and Road” counties include:

**Eastern Asia:** Mongolia

**Ten countries in ASEAN:** Singapore, Malaysia, Indonesia, Burma, Thailand, Laos, Cambodia, Vietnam, Brunei and the Philippines

**18 countries in Western Asia:** Iran, Iraq, Turkey, Syria, Jordan, Lebanon, Israel, Palestine, Saudi Arabia, Yemen, Oman, the United Arab Emirates, Qatar, Kuwait, Bahrain, Greece, Cyprus, and Egypt

**Eight countries in Southern Asia:** India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Afghanistan, Sri Lanka, Maldives, Nepal and Bhutan

**Five countries in Central Asia:** Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Turkmenistan, Tajikistan and Kyrgyzstan

**Seven countries in CIS:** Russia, Ukraine, Belarus, Georgia, Azerbaijan, Armenia and Moldova

**16 countries in Central and Eastern Europe:** Poland, Lithuania, Estonia, Latvia, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Hungary, Slovenia, Croatia, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Republic of Montenegro, Serbia, Albania, Romania, Bulgaria, and Macedonia

The incentive scheme should be explained by Beijing Capital International Airport Co., Ltd..

The incentive scheme should be implemented from August 15, 2017 to September 30, 2019.
