Flight Arrival

After getting off the airplane, you enter into the terminal via the air bridge or a shuttle bus.

Transfer Procedures

Passenger holding a connecting flight boarding pass: Please verify the boarding gate of your flight via the flight display screen or attendants at the Information Desk, and then follow the guiding signs for the transfer circuit to head for the boarding gate.

Passenger without connecting flight boarding pass: Please follow the guiding signs for the transfer passenger in the terminal to go to the Transfer Counter at 2nd floor for check-in on the connecting flight.

Friendly Reminder: Currently, transfer to some flights is not available. For details, please inquire the Transfer Counter or attendants. In case of failure to check in there, please claim your baggage at the Baggage Claim Hall at first, and then go to the departure level and go through the whole international departure procedures: baggage check/boarding pass issuance, inspection of quarantine and immigration, security check, customs inspection, waiting for boarding.

Notice of carrying Liquids, Gels and Aerosols on Flights

1. Except a small amount of cosmetics for use-self, all passengers on domestic flights are prohibited from carrying with them any liquids, gels and aerosols (LAGs) whereas they could be transported as checked luggage. And packaging of LAGs must be in compliance with relevant air transport rules and regulations.

2. Passengers are allowed to carry with a small amount of cosmetics, except Shampoo, Conditioner, Bath liquid, Depilatory paste, Bodybuilding cream. Only one piece of each type is allowed and the capacity of the container must not exceed 100ml. Cosmetics shall be placed in separate bags and are subject to security checks. The capacities of the container exceed 100ml (even the container is not filled with liquid), could be transported as checked luggage.

3. Passenger accompanied by infants may apply to airlines for free liquid milk products to be served on board the aircraft while purchasing tickets. Passengers with diabetes or other patients may carry necessary liquid medicines provided that these medicines pass security checks and shall be kept in the custody of cabin crew members.

4. Passengers shall bear all responsibilities themselves in case of any consequences arising from their violations of the foregoing regulations.

Waiting and Boarding

Waiting for boarding: After handling transfer procedures, you can follow guiding signs to go to right boarding gate. Please pay attention to flight information display and broadcasted flight information.

Boarding for Domestic Flight: Please arrive at the boarding gate at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled take-off time.

Friendly Reminder:

To guarantee successful boarding, please take good care of your boarding pass. Do not fold it.
